## TAKE A MARCH 24 DAY TRIP INTO UTAH'S PAST

### Concerts, tours, film and art exhibits slated for first-ever Old Capitol Storytelling Festival in Fillmore

Native American storyteller and flute player Nino Reyos is just one of more than 30 storytellers headlining the first-ever Old Capitol Storytelling Festival to be held in Central Utah March 22-26. Although many tours, film screenings, exhibits, performances and activities of the festival are spread over several days, the bulk of public events are concentrated in Fillmore Saturday, March 24.

"This is a great opportunity to take a day trip into the heart of Utah, celebrating its past, present and future," said musician and arts advocate Clive Romney, a key event organizer.

On Saturday alone, eight storytelling concerts will be held at the state-of-the-art Millard High School Auditorium, located at 200 Eagle Avenue in Fillmore. Six of those events are free. The other two concerts, scheduled for 1 pm and 2:15 pm and featuring the One Voice Children's Choir of *America's Got Talent* fame, cost \$5 per person or \$20 per family.
